Other Things to Know...

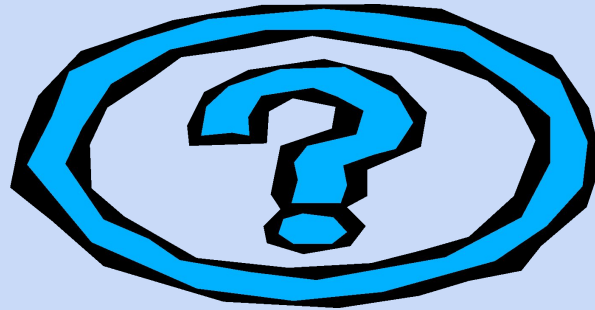
First Day of School:
